PROGRAMME PROGRESSION AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is made between

Rose Bruford College

(the Higher Education “receiver” institution)

AND

Mid Kent College

(the “provider” institution)

The AGREEMENT concerns student progression to:

BA Scenic Arts

FROM

BTEC National Diploma Performing Arts (Acting, Dance, Musical Theatre)

The parties to this Agreement have agreed that a learner shall be guaranteed an interview on the specified HE programme, subject to the learner meeting the criteria set out below:

Reference and prior agreement from L3 course leader (UCAS form)

The parties to this Agreement have agreed to provide the following pre-application guidance and support:

3 points of contact per annum with FE students by Rose Bruford staff

The parties to this Agreement have agreed that a learner shall be guaranteed a place on the specified HE programme, subject to the learner meeting the criteria set out below:

- **BTEC National Diploma at merit or above – 240 UCAS tariff points, subject to variation in exceptional circumstances**
- **Portfolio of evidence and successful interview**

Both parties agree to participate in annual monitoring and review to ensure that any changes which might affect this Progression Agreement (e.g, changes in course content) are taken account of.
