

The Creative Way Progression Agreement Scheme

PROGRAMME PROGRESSION AGREEMENT

This AGREEMENT is made between

**South East Essex College (SEEC)
(the Higher Education “receiver” institution)**

AND

**Newham 6th Form College (NewVIC)
(the “provider” institution)**

The AGREEMENT concerns student progression to:

BA Graphic Design

FROM

BTEC National Diploma Art & Design

The parties to this Agreement have agreed that a learner shall be guaranteed an interview on the specified HE programme, subject to the learner meeting the criteria set out below:

GCSE English grade C or above (or equivalent Key Skills qualification)

The parties to this Agreement have agreed to provide the following pre-application guidance and support:

It is anticipated that HE Course Leaders will be available to visit and meet with year one level 3 students at the provider institution sometime towards the end of the spring term/beginning of the summer term. This visit would be used to disseminate information, advice and guidance and also to promote the College's Art & Design Graduate exhibition in the hope that students/ staff from the provider will visit the receiver institution. Staff from the receiver institution would also be available to conduct 'portfolio review sessions' with any students seriously considering the receiver in their UCAS application

The parties to this Agreement have agreed that a learner shall be guaranteed a place on the specified HE programme, subject to the learner meeting the criteria set out below:

- BTEC National Diploma (160 UCAS points and above)**
- Portfolio or evidence and successful interview**

Both parties agree to participate in annual monitoring and review to ensure that any changes which might affect this Progression Agreement (e.g, changes in course content) are taken account of.
